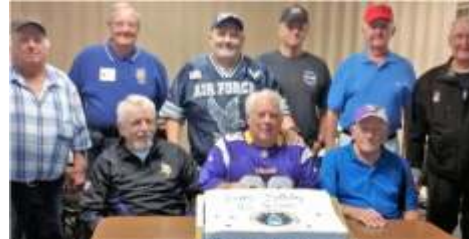
COMMANDERS CORNER

Hello to all Squadron 21 members,

Eligibility for Membership:

All male descendants, adopted sons and stepsons of members of The American Legion, and such male descendants of veterans who died in service during World I, World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, Lebanon, Grenada, Panama, the Persian Gulf War and the War on Terrorism, during the delimiting periods set forth in Article IV, Section 1, of the National Constitution of The American Legion, or who died subsequent to their honorable discharge from such service, shall be eligible for membership in the Sons of The American Legion. There shall be no forms or class of membership except an active membership.

The American Legion eligibility dates

- Aug. 2, 1990 — cessation of hostilities as determined by the U.S. government
- Dec. 20, 1989 — Jan. 31, 1990
- Aug. 24, 1982 — July 31, 1984
- Feb. 28, 1961 — May 7, 1975
- June 25, 1950 — Jan. 31, 1955
- Dec. 7, 1941 — Dec. 31, 1946
- April 6, 1917 — Nov. 11, 1918

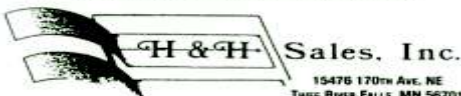

The Fargo VA Health Care System will hold free flu shot clinics for enrolled Veterans from September through November in North Dakota and Minnesota.

Below are dates, times and locations enrolled Veterans can receive their free flu shots:

Fargo VA Medical Center 3rd floor auditorium:

Sept. 29, Oct. 6, Oct. 18, Oct. 25 – 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Oct. 12, Nov. 2 – 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

For after-hours flu shots, enrolled Veterans can visit the following primary care teams at the Fargo VAMC regardless of which team provides them care:

Red Team: Oct. 11 – 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Gold Team: Oct. 18 – 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Blue Team: Nov. 5 – 8 a.m. to NOON

The VA has teamed up with Walgreens again this year to provide free flu vaccinations for enrolled Veterans. This flu season, the partnership between VA and Walgreens continues through March 31, 2017.

All Veterans who are currently enrolled in VA care may walk into any of the over 8,000 Walgreens nationally to receive a vaccination at no cost. After presenting a Veterans Identification Card and a photo ID, a Walgreens pharmacist administers the vaccine and transmits that information securely to VA where it becomes part of the patient's electronic medical record.

This program has been especially beneficial to enrolled Veterans who live in rural areas. Because many may live at greater distances from VA medical facilities, the Walgreens/VA partnership provides increased access to no-cost flu vaccinations. Last year 29 percent of the VA patients who received a flu shot at Walgreens were classified as rural or highly rural.

Veterans Still Serving America - Legacy and Vision in Clay County

In conjunction with the 100th birthday of the American Legion, Beyond the Yellow Ribbon has started research on the history of Veterans and Veterans' organizations in Clay County, MN, our Legacy. The coordinating committee will provide a framework for the future, our Vision.

Community non-profits, veterans' organizations, businesses and colleges will be presenting programs honoring our Veterans. Organizations that have committed to joining in the celebration are listed below along with tentative project plans. Historical and Cultural Society of Clay County (HCSCC) will research of Veterans organizations in Moorhead and Clay County in preparation for a WWI exhibit. Moorhead Community Access Media (MCAM) will create Public Service Announcements for Events and record and broadcast events on Community Access channels. Moorhead Public Library (LARL) will schedule storytelling and book reading events. Heritage Education Commission (HEC) will conduct oral histories of Veterans and have special sessions on Veterans for the 2018 Family History Workshop. The Rourke Art Gallery Museum will host a Veterans Artist show. The League of Women Voters of the Red River Valley will do events related to Women in the Military. MSUM Alumni will host special events for Veterans at Homecoming 2018.
