## Clay County Veterans Service Office

Hope all is well!

VA's final rule to consider certain diseases associated with exposure to contaminants in the water supply at Camp Lejeune as presumptive for service connection. This rule became effective March 14, 2017. There are eight presumptive diseases: Adult Leukemia, aplastic anemia and other myelodysplastic syndromes, bladder cancer, kidney cancer, liver cancer, multiple myeloma, non-Hodgkin's lymphoma, Parkinson's disease.

The veterans service office continues to monitor legislation and the veteran bills. I will keep you updated when or if passed.

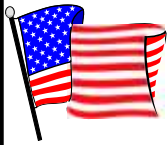


